Day-to-Day & Trial-to-Trial move ups available both days.

Trial entry limits: 120 runs or 8 hours of judging (whichever is less) per judge per day

The trial **OPENS December 1, 2017 & CLOSSES December 29, 2018.**

Day of Show Entries will be allowed if trial is not full.

*Dogs are required to have a Barn Hunt Registration number to show in Barn Hunt. Register your dog online at: www.barnhunt.com. Allow at least 48 hours to receive a Barn Hunt number. Handlers are responsible for entering and writing legibly the correct Barn Hunt number for their dog on entry form. An incorrect number may result in any legs earned being forfeited.

Directions to the site: Located at 3820 S Pennsylvania Avenue, St Francis, WI 53235

(White, cement-block building on the southeast corner. Parking lot on the east side.)

- From the North: Take 43 South to 94 East to 794 South to Howard Ave exit. Left 1 block to Pennsylvania Ave. Left on Pennsylvania Ave. 1 block to Cudahy Kennel Club on the right.
- From the South: Take 94 West (head North) to Howard Ave. Exit right on Howard Ave. and continue until Pennsylvania Ave. Turn Left on Pennsylvania, 1 block to Cudahy Kennel Club on the right.
- From West: 94 East to 794 South to Howard Ave exit. Left 1 block to Pennsylvania Ave. Left on Pennsylvania Ave. 1 block to Cudahy Kennel Club on the right.

Running Order: The running order and further scheduling details will be emailed to all exhibitors no later than **Tuesday, January 2nd** after the number of entries is known for each class. If you do not receive an email by Tuesday night, please contact the trial secretary. Dogs will be run in height order, but dogs being handled by the same person will be separated into different staged blinds.

Judging will not begin before 8 am.

Height divisions: Dogs 13" and under - Small Dogs 13.1 to 18" - Medium Dogs over 18" – Large

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice, Open, Senior, and Master classes in each height division. Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in all classes. High in Class Awards will be offered in Novice through Master. New Title Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a title for Novice through Master as well as Crazy 8s.

Turn R onto S 108th St to Vet Clinic.

Volunteers: Volunteers are very important to any Barn Hunt Trial. We will make sure that you have enough time to walk your dog before you run. We want everyone to have a pleasant experience in Barn Hunt while at the same time helping to make the trial run smoothly. We'll make sure that you are instructed on how to do a job so that it is fun. All volunteers will receive free lunch and beverages during the day to show our appreciation for your help.

**Be sure to have fun with your dog, hug them, give them a scratch behind the ear,
 and let them know how SPECIAL they are after every run.
 They are truly a gift from God to us!**

Exhibitor Information:

All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all returned checks. Make check payable to CAPER. Send entries & fees to the trial secretary.

No phone entries. You can submit entries via email to the trial secretary's address, with payment made by following directions at www.caper-dogs.com/BarnHuntPayPalCCpayment.htm.

There will be crating space available inside the building but please make sure that your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited.

There is **NO SMOKING** in this facility or on the grounds. If you must smoke, you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle.

The safety of the dogs, and rats, are our primary concerns. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, may be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Dog exercise area: Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building (green dumpster). Please be considerate about picking up after your dog(s) and leaving the grounds as you found them. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused from the trial grounds without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement per BHA regulations.

Collars and Leashes: Electronic collars and devices are not allowed on trial grounds. Head halters and prong collars are not allowed on test grounds. At no time should dogs be tied out or otherwise left attached to something other than a human. Dogs may not be brought to the line in any disallowed collar. Dogs may not be brought to the line on flexi-leads. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dogs MUST run "naked," without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses that can be easily and quickly removed and replaced. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog and/or owner/handler is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial.

Entry fees for sick/injured dogs may be refunded after the closing date minus \$5.00 per run. Refunds must accompany a letter/email from your veterinarian.

Bitches in Season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will run at the end of their class and must be run in panties. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes on December 29, 2017 entry fees will not be refunded. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial committee prior to the trial and you must inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

Loud/Disruptive dogs; Dogs that are loud and disruptive may be asked to locate away from the rings/crating area and/or staged away from the other dogs getting ready to compete.

Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial if justification is found to do so by the judge and/or trial committee. Terrier sparring is not allowed on trial grounds.

Any dog that is sick, injured or lame will be excused from the trial grounds.

Trial grounds will consist of the entire grounds of Cudahy Kennel Club and extend to the hotel.

Food: The club will NOT have food for sale. Food will be provided for workers. There are fast food restaurants within a short drive. You are also welcome to bring your own food/beverages in.
