Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CST Friday, February 16 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date. A veterinarian certificate must be received by the Trial Secretary within 7 days of the trial to obtain a refund.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front & back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers to Best of Breed & higher Obedience or Rally classes: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Obedience & Rally entries can be transferred to the next higher level in the given entered program. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging for the show.

SITE INFORMATION

Sweepstakes and Conformation classes will be held in a room off the front of the building. Obedience and Rally events will be in an adjacent room from conformation, with a separate entrance off the back of the building. Rally classes will start 45 minutes after the concluding of Obedience classes.

Please turn all cell phones or pagers to Silent before entering the ring areas.

Opening time of the building each morning will be posted in the judging schedule. No dogs may be left at the show site overnight.

Chalking is allowed ONLY in the plastic covered grooming areas.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE

From the North: I-94 south to IL Hwy 120. West on 120 to Hwy 12. South on 12 to Case Rd, turn right. Site is on the left.

OR toll-free route: I-94 south to Hwy C/Wilmot Rd, west to Hwy 83, turn left. 83 into Antioch, right onto Hwy 59, continue onto Hwy 12 to Case Rd, turn right. Site is on the left.

From the South/Southwest and East: I-90 to the IL-53 exit toward NW Suburbs. Follow signs for Kirchoff Rd & merge right onto IL-53 N. North 7.7 miles to Lake Cook Rd. Exit on left, go west <1 mile to Rand Rd/US-12W, turn right. Travel 12.9 miles to W Case Rd. Turn left, site is on the left.

From the West: US-20 E to Marengo; left onto IL-23N/S State St. for half a mile. Right onto IL-176E/Telegraph St.; follow IL-176 east 24 miles to N Darrell Rd, turn left. In 2.4 miles turn right onto W Case Rd. Site is on right.

RINGSIDE: Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when their class is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not at ringside when required.

AGREEMENT
