



## SITE INFORMATION:

This event is being held at a private residence. **Exhibitors MUST clean up after their dogs and themselves!** Please bring your own chairs and shade tents/screens as there is little shade available. Availability of food & beverages will be communicated in the judging schedule.

Dogs MUST be confined in vehicles or crated. Crates/ex-pens need to be placed only in the areas designated by the Trial Committee. Dogs should be leashed when not in the arena.

All sheep trial classes will be in a 105'x210' arena. A course duck classes will be in a 50'x100' arena. B course outruns will be 60 feet for Started, 75 feet for Intermediate and 100 feet for Advanced. HT will be in a 100'x100' arena, PT in a 105'x210' arena.

Moveup requests need to be given to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the day's test/trial. If there are Alternate entries, all alternates must report to the Trial Secretary before the start of the day's classes. If you do not, your spot may be given to an alternate in an earlier class.

Bitches in season will run last in the Test classes and in catalog order in the Trial classes.

## DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

**From Chicago/east:** I-90 west to IL Hwy 47. Go north to Hwy 14. Go west (left) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front).

**From Milwaukee/northeast:** I-43 south to Hwy 120. Go south on 120 - it becomes Hwy 47 at the IL state line. Follow Hwy 47 through Woodstock to Hwy 14. Go west (right) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front).

**From MN/northwest:** I-90 east to US Hwy 20, go east to IL Hwy 47. North (left) on 47 to Hwy 14. Go west (left) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front).

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damages to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

**I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering; i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); Collie (rough, smooth); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles).

2. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
