Entry Payment:

By check or money order (made out to CAPER) or by **Zelle** (to secretary@caper-dogs.com). These methods have no extra fee. One check or Zelle payment is sufficient for all your dogs' entries.

By **PayPal or credit card** at caper-dogs.com, PayPal/Credit Card link. **Payment must include \$2 per class additional charge for the entries to be valid.**

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CST Wednesday, January 28 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is preferred) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry pended; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via Zelle, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per class, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date, if written notice is given to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of obedience/rally classes.

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers to higher levels: Transfers are available to dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements to advance to a higher level after the closing date, in any offered sport. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for which the transfer is requested.

Best Puppy (AM shows) & Best Bred By Exhibitor (PM shows)

First place in each 6-9 and 9-12 class will compete for Best Puppy. If a puppy is BOV or BOW in their variety, only that puppy will compete against the other variety for Best Puppy.

First place in each BBE class will compete for Best BBE. If a BBE class winner is BOV or BOW in their variety, only that BBE dog/bitch will compete against the other variety for Best BBE.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show. The Open class is divided (ages as of the day of the show):

Master class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES (Saturday am only)

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Collies who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. All Sweepstakes entrants **MUST ALSO** be entered in a Regular Class at either Saturday specialty show. **Any puppy placing in sweepstakes and not shown in the Regular Classes, unless excused by the veterinarian, will be subject to forfeiture of all sweepstakes awards and prizes.** Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating the entry in Sweepstakes in the space for "Additional Classes."

Rough and smooth coats will be combined in the classes. Classes divided by sex.

6 mos & under 9 mos • 9 mos & under 12 mos • 12 mos & under 18 mos

DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

25% of fees will be retained by Club for expenses. The remaining 75% will be awarded to:

Best in Sweepstakes - 20% of total entry Best of Opposite Sex -10% of total entry

Balance will be divided among the winners in each class as follows (percentages are based on entry fees for each class): First Prize-40% • Second Prize- 30% • Third Prize- 20% • Fourth Prize- 10%.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Collies that are 4 months of age but under 6 months on the day of the event. An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for each entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs/has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last 5 years.
- All entries must be received by the closing date. No entries will be taken at ringside.

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex. The Best of Breed winner will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the total number of dogs competing. The Best of Opposite Sex winner will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex.

The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

Dogs Competing – Points: 2 dogs: 1 pt • 4 dogs: 2 pts • 8 dogs: 3 pts • 12 dogs: 4 pts • 16 dogs: 5 pts

PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTION

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a Pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children at least 5 years of age and under 9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog.

Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

The class will be held between the two specialty shows. **Registration is required each day and will be 9-10am at the show site.** Cost is \$5 per entry, paid at the time of registration. Each entry's adult member will sign a liability release as part of the entry process.



DIRECTIONS TO SITE

From the east, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 ~3.7 miles to Algonquin Rd and turn left. Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

From the west, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Rd and turn right. Drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Rd. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right onto Main St. Drive 1.4 miles on Main St to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Algonquin Road and turn left. 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
