### DIRECTIONS TO SITE

**From the east**, take I-90 to the Route 47 exit. Go north on Route 47 ~3.7 miles to Oakcrest Dr and turn left (known as Algonquin Rd to the right). Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

**From the west**, take I-90 to the Route 20 exit. Go west (left) 1.6 miles to Harmony Rd and turn right Drive 3.7 miles to the stop sign, then turn left to stay on Harmony Rd. Drive to the next stop sign and turn right onto Main St. Drive 1.4 miles on Main St to Route 47 and turn left. Go .4 miles north on Route 47 to Oakcrest Dr (known as Algonquin Road to the right) and turn left. Take the first left onto Wolf Dr and then immediately turn right into the business park. Go straight to the end of the drive and turn left. CDA is in the last section of the building on the left.

## JUDGING PROGRAM

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in this program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having their dog ready at ringside at the scheduled time. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated for calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

For your convenience, the published class divisions have been carefully tabulated; however neither the club nor the Show/Trial Secretary assumes responsibility for absolute accuracy.

### TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

Handlers who wish to transfer their dogs to a higher level class in any event must notify the Event Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the event.

### SITE INFORMATION: READ CAREFULLY!

DO NOT COME EARLIER THAN 8 AM FRIDAY or BEFORE 6:45 AM SAT & SUN.  
The building will not be open until these times.

**Parking:** Do not park in spots directly in front of the gymnastics business next to CDA. If you have dogs in vehicles that bark, you MUST park behind the CDA building so the neighbors in homes to the west are not disturbed.

**Exercise areas:** Do not walk your dog on the west (fence) side of the drainage area. You can use any other grass area including the east (parking lot) side of the drainage area.

**Protective matting is required under all wire crates and metal chairs to protect the flooring.**

There will be tarps covering the matting in the large crating/grooming area, but please check any ringside chair legs to be sure they will not damage the flooring,

No dogs are allowed in the building overnight. No overnight parking is allowed.
