#### Final Closing date **May 14 at 6 pm**

after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted except as provided for in Ch 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules

**Entry Limits:** 25 sheep runs per day  
15 duck runs per day

Sheep: Course A all levels

Ducks: Course A & B all levels

**Entry fees:** \$55.00 per trial entry (sheep or ducks)

#### **Entry Payment:**

By **check or money order** (made out to CAPER) or by **Zelle** (to secretary@caper-dogs.com). These methods have no extra fee. One check or Zelle payment is sufficient for all your dogs' entries.

By **PayPal or credit card** at caper-dogs.com, PayPal/Credit Card link. **Payment must include \$2 per class additional charge for the entries to be valid.**

All mail must be left with no acceptance signature required. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST** be received **in writing** prior to the May 14 closing date, be legible and include the AKC number, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted. Email changes are welcomed. No refunds for duplicate entries or entry form errors.

Entries not on official herding entry forms, or photocopies of entry forms, without the Release Form on the reverse side of the entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from the competition by actions of the Trial Committee. Refunds of entries pulled after closing date will be made as long as an alternate runs; if no alternate runs, no refund will be given. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire or Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Bitches in season will run in catalog order.

**For Exhibition Only trial entries will be accepted** if entry limits are not reached. FEO entries will be \$25 each. Scores will not be recorded and will not count toward AKC herding titles.

## DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

**From Chicago/east:** I-90 west to IL Hwy 47. Go north to Hwy 14. Go west (left) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front). Follow gravel drive to barn area for parking.

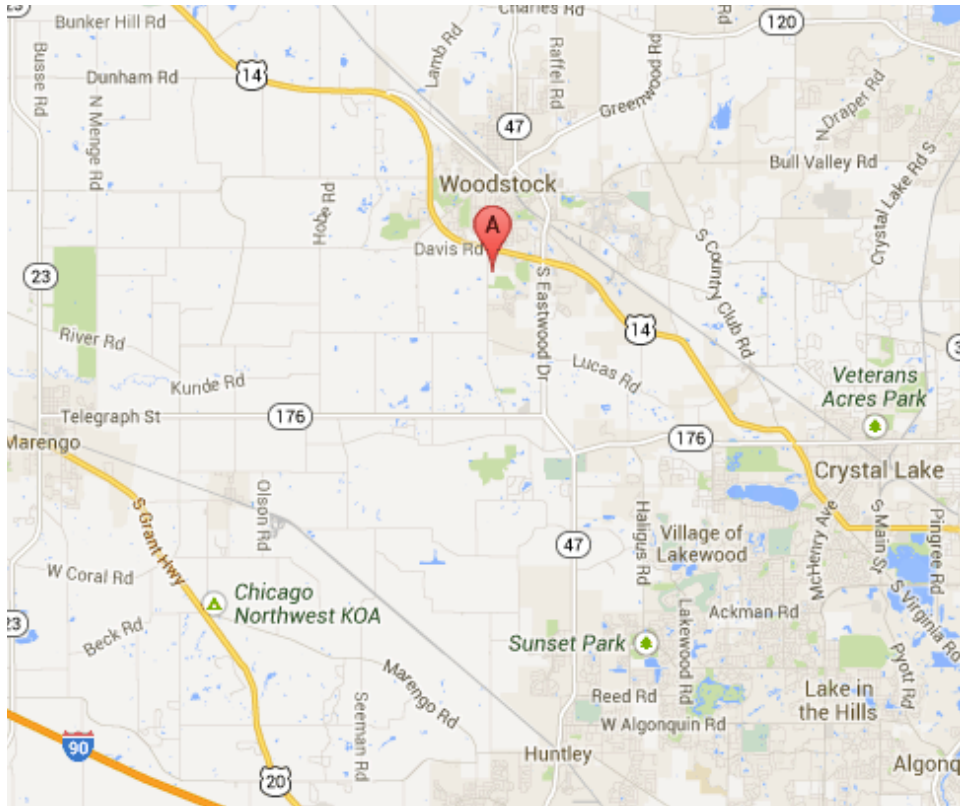
**From Milwaukee/northeast:** I-43 south to Hwy 120. Go south on 120 - it becomes Hwy 47 at the IL state line. Follow Hwy 47 through Woodstock to Hwy 14. Go west (right) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front). Follow gravel drive to barn area for parking.

**From MN/northwest:** I-90 east to US Hwy 20, go east to IL Hwy 47. North (left) on 47 to Hwy 14. Go west (left) on Hwy 14 to the first light (Dean St). Turn south (left) approximately 1/2 mile to first house on left (white fence in front). Follow gravel drive to barn area for parking.

**SITE INFORMATION:** This event is being held at a private residence. **Exhibitors MUST clean up after their dogs and themselves!** Please bring your own chairs and shade tents/screens as there is little shade available. Availability of food & beverages will be communicated in the judging schedule.

Dogs MUST be confined in vehicles or crated. Crates/ex-pens need to be placed only in the areas designated by the Trial Committee. Dogs should be leashed when not in the arena.

All sheep trial classes will be in a 105'x210' arena. A course duck classes will be in a 50'x100' arena. B course outruns will be minimum distances.

If there are Alternate entries, all alternates must report to the Trial Secretary before the start of the day's classes. If you do not, your spot may be given to an alternate in an earlier class.

## PRIZES AND AWARDS (each day):

High in Trial: Large Goodie Bag & Blue/Red/Yellow Rosette

Reserve High In Trial: Small Goodie Bag & Red/Yellow/White Rosette

Placements: Ribbon (1st Blue, 2nd Red, 3rd Yellow, 4th White, 5th Pink)
