### **Entry Payment:**

By **check or money order** (US funds, made out to CAPER) or by **Zelle** (to secretary@caper-dogs.com). These methods have no extra fee. One check or Zelle payment is sufficient for all your dogs' entries.

By **PayPal or credit card** at caper-dogs.com, PayPal/Credit Card link. Please send a separate payment for the total of each dog's entries. **Payment must include \$2 per class additional charge for the entries to be valid.**

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm Wednesday, September 2 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is preferred) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club. All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry pending; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via Zelle, PayPal, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing.

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds for bitches in season in agility, obedience or rally will be refunded less \$5/entry if notice is made to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of judging of that sport.

**Entry Errors:** Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

**Transfers:** Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Transfers to a higher level in Junior Showmanship may also be made. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the show in which to be moved.

### ROOM RESPONSIBILITY

Any individual attending an HPCA Sanctioned Event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dogs on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairgrounds and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject disciplinary action by the HPCA Board of Directors.

The owners should bring sheets to place over the beds in guestrooms with dogs. Dogs are to be allowed on furniture ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.

All dogs must be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog. All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated, no soft-sided crates.

Housekeepers will not have to service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Moreover, they will be required to report this rule violation to hotel management. Individual room occupants will be assessed for any damage or destruction to their room.

There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms and no hotel towels will be used for this purpose.

All owner/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.

Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages. Damages shall be defined as flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).

**BY SIGNING ANY HPCA ENTRY FORM, COMPLIANCE WITH THIS POLICY SHALL BE INSURED. ALL INDIVIDUALS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY.**

Exit 149 (East Woodmen Road) from I-25

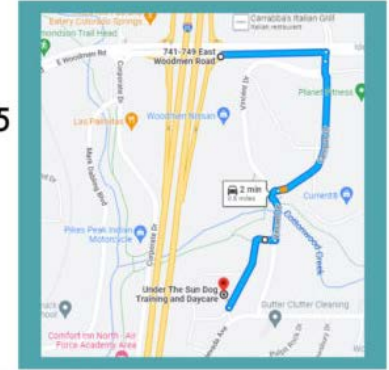
Head northeast on E Woodmen Rd

### Directions from UTS to Twin Flame Farm

The traffic will probably dictate your route.

Here are two, but we recommend using a GPS.

*Using I-76 (right through Denver):* Take I-76 to Exit 22 Bromley Ln - head east for 8.7 miles. Follow the road to the right (Imboden Rd) for 1.1 miles. Road turns to the left (144 Ave) for 1.3 miles. Twin Flame Farm on the right.

*Using E-470 N (around Denver):* Follow I-25 N for 45 miles to Exit 194 toward Limon on E-470 N. Go 30 miles and take exit 31, turning right onto 96th Ave. Go 6.3 miles and turn left onto Trussville St. Go 0.7 miles and turn right onto E120th Ave. Go 4.5 miles and turn left onto Imboden Rd. Go 3.1 miles and turn right onto E 144th Av. Go 1.3 miles and turn right to your destination.

Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) shown with at least two of their offspring.

Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excuses.

Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

**Award of Merit:** At the judge's discretion, up to one Award of Merit will be given for every ten Pumik entered in the Best of Breed competition. AOMs should be awarded to those dogs and bitches that the judge feels are of equal merit to the Best of Breed winner. BOB, BOS & Selects do not receive Awards of Merit.

**National Owner Handler Series** is offered - see page 13 for details.

**Best Puppy** – all 6 winners of 6-9 and 9-12 Regular, and Puppy BBE, classes compete for Best Puppy

### Best Bred By Exhibitor

- To be eligible for Bred-by-Exhibitor the appropriate box on the entry form must be checked.
- Every dog entered at this event in any class is eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition, if the entry is shown by a breeder/owner of record.
- Dogs in competition for Best Bred-by-Exhibitor must be handled throughout the entire breed competition by a breeder/owner of record.
- No handler change will be permitted for the purpose of becoming eligible for the Best BBE competition.

**Best Veteran** – winners of all veterans classes compete for Best Veteran

### POINTS FOR RESERVE WINNERS

At both Specialties, the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will each be awarded a three-point major, provided that there are at least 12 dogs and at least 12 bitches entered in the regular classes (twice the number required for a 5 point major).

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (both Specialties)

**Novice class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**Open class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

The Novice & Open classes are divided (ages as of the day of the show):

Junior - 9 years and under 12 years

Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years

Senior - 15 years and under 18 years

**Master class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

## SWEEPSTAKES (both Specialties)

### Puppy Sweepstakes

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Pumik who are 6 months but less than 18 months old on the day of the sweepstakes. Dogs must also be entered in one of the Specialty regular classes. Classes are divided by sex.

6 mos & under 9 mos • 9 mos & under 12 mos • 12 mos & under 18 mos

### Veteran Sweepstakes

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Pumik who are at least 7 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants may be altered and need not be entered in a regular class. Classes are divided by sex.

7 yrs & under 10 yrs • 10 yrs & over

### DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

10% will be deducted from each entry fee to help defray Sweepstakes expenses. The remainder (the "entry fund") will be divided amongst the class placements, determined by the number of entries:

## 4-TO-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY (both Specialties)

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Pumik that are four months of age but under six months on the day of the event. An AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for each entry. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs/has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last 5 years.

**Titles** - The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Best of Breed will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated. Best of Opposite Sex will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex.

The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

**Dogs Competing** – Points: 2 dogs: 1 pt • 4 dogs: 2 pts • 8 dogs: 3 pts • 12 dogs: 4 pts • 16 dogs: 5 pts

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

\* Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

## AGILITY

**Entries open Wednesday, July 29 at 8am CDT. Entries received before then are invalid.**  
**Entries close Wednesday, September 2 at 6pm CDT.**

There will be TWO agility trials held on one day. Entries are limited to 250 runs total for the day. Entries are accepted via First Received method. No envelope can have more than 10 dogs' entries included.

This agility trial is open to Pumik 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Except for dogs needing measurement, dogs are not required to be at the trial until their scheduled time of judging. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged.

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height class. All measurements at the dog's withers.

The herding tests & trials are open to all Hungarian herding breeds (Puli, Pumi & Mudi) 9 months of age or older (Instinct Test open to dogs 6 months or older) that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Due to entry limits on runs, priority will be given to Pumi entries. Bitches in season are eligible and will run at the end of the level in tests and in catalog order in trials.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until their scheduled time of judging. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when the class is to be judged.

### STOCK & REPLACEMENT VALUE

Sheep: \$300/head

In the event of death or injury to any sheep, the exhibitor will be responsible for the replacement fees listed above. Injury Definition: Any injury that caused the sheep not to be able to continue to be used that day or the next day due to the injury. ## SCENT WORK

**Entries open Wednesday, July 29 at 8am CDT. Entries received before then are invalid.**

**Entries close Wednesday, September 2 at 6pm CDT.**

- There will be TWO scent work trials held on one day. Entries are limited to 125 runs total for the day. Entries are accepted via First Received method. No envelope can have more than 10 dogs' entries included.
- This trial is open to all Pumik 6 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP)
- Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.
- By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.
- WAIT LIST: A wait list will be held to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries must be received by the closing date/time. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing, unless replaced by a waitlisted entry. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.
- CLASSES AND ORDER: Novice, Advanced and Excellent Container & Interior are offered in each trial. The briefing & start times, and the order of the elements & class levels, will be determined after closing and will be outlined in the judging schedule.
- MOVEUPS: Pre-trial moveups must be received by 6pm CDT on Monday September 12 via email only, sent to [secretary@caper-dogs.com](mailto:secretary@caper-dogs.com). Moveups between trials will be available. Moveups must be received by the onsite secretary in writing no later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of Trial 1 for each element.
- COLLARS, LEASHES & HARNESSSES: During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro, if desired, may be mounted to the dog's harness or on the handler's body. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material. All dogs must be on leash at all times. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.
- POSSESSION OF ODORS AND TRAINING: Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area." The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.
- SPECTATORS may or may not be allowed depending on the available search area sizes, and this will be announced in the morning briefing.
- SEARCH AREA CONDITIONS: Searches will be indoors on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

- There will be TWO Fetch Tests held on one day. [Pre-entries at this link](#) or you can download an entry form [here](#).
- DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER. This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Bitches in season are not eligible to compete..
- DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER. This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Bitches in season are not eligible to compete..
- CONDITION OF THE DOG. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.
- SIGN-IN AND CRATING AREAS. Testing will be Tuesday afternoon, September 22. An exact time will be posted in the Pumifest judging program and on the HPCA Pumifest website at <https://pumiclub.org/events/pumifest/>. There will be a secretary table with entry forms available or the entry form can be downloaded [here](#). This table will be also used for check-ins and information. You will receive your armband number after your entry form is accepted. Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event. Dogs will be crated out of view of the Fetch test area, or far enough away as to not cause a distraction to the dog being tested.
- COLLARS, LEASHES AND HARNESSSES. Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, or Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.
- REFUNDS. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Test Committee. Dogs pulled because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.
- RINGSIDE. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready in the competition area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide

### CHIC DNA BLOOD DRAW

#### Wednesday

Has your Pumi had its DNA banked yet? It is very important we get as many Pumi as possible to have their DNA submitted for future research. We have a relatively young, healthy population of dogs at the present but don't know what health problems the future holds. Previous DNA submissions have already discovered that some Pumi carry the gene for Degenerative Myelopathy. Submitting your dog's DNA now can help future researchers in their quest for a new discovery. Please consider donating your dog's DNA at Pumifest, if you haven't done so previously. This only takes a couple of minutes and your Pumi is good to go immediately afterwards.

This is a simple blood draw and will be performed by a licensed veterinary technician. The fee of \$10 is a reduced fee based on quantity submissions from the HPCA.
