Entries must be received by 6:00 pm CDT Wednesday, May 28th, 2025 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature.

Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$5 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date, if notification is made to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of obedience/rally classes.

NON-TITLING CLASSES OFFERED

Rally Pairs: One handler, two dogs, working together through a novice rally course. This is similar to 'Brace' in obedience, with the option of the dogs being connected to each other. Scores will be based on a possible 200 points with ties being broken by time.

Team Rally: Four Handlers, Four Dogs! A fifth dog may be entered as an alternate at no additional fee, however, only four dogs may compete on the team. No dog may be entered on more than one team for that level. Dogs can compete at any level despite their title. Each dog and handler team will run the course individually and be scored individually, however the team time starts when the judge says 'Forward' with the first team member and ends when the fourth team member crosses the FINISH sign. The time runs continuously, as in a relay race! Team scoring is based on 400 points, or 100 points per team member. **Important: Please have all members of your team indicate your team name when you enter. The team alternate must indicate "Alternate for "Team name"**

Transfers will be allowed in accordance with AKC regulations. Transfers must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers will be accepted prior to day of trial.

Entered bitches who come into season after closing are eligible to receive entry fee refunds less \$5 per entry if written notice is given to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of rally classes.

- 1 (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2 The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3 (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
